Dear Parents/Carers

Hello all and welcome to the summer holidays! This newsletter outlines arrangements for results day and the start of the new academic year but in this uncertain situation these are not confirmed and may be subject to change. Any changes or news will be sent to you via email and text so please ensure that we have the correct details for you. If there are any changes to your details please contact katie.nickson@evertonfreeschool.com.

Pre-season training would normally commence week beginning 10th August, however this obviously at present will not be possible. We are awaiting guidance from the FA and our facilities to safely open. Once this happens, we will assess the situation again and keep you updated. If we can train, it will likely be late August or early September. Again, this will be communicated via text, email and on our twitter account @EvertonCollege.

You should have been sent forms for kit, bursary and consent which includes details of exam administration, learner support, details about free school meals and so on. It is important that these are returned to college via post or electronically. If you do not have a copy of these, they will be available on results day or email info@evertonfreeschool.com. Alternatively, you can find them on our website www.evertonfootballcollege.com.

To comply with health and safety and Covid-19 restrictions, we will open for GCSE Results day only. Level 3 BTEC results will be available on the 12th August. These will be sent electronically via email to all our yr13 students.

For those students transferring from another centre to our Yr 13 BTEC level 3 programme it is

vitaly important that you obtain your year results and certificate. Without these we will not be able to enrol you to study with us in September. If this applies to you, (I know some of you are transferring from Burscough, Liverpool College, St Margaret's and Knowsley College) you need to attend our Spellow Lane site L4 4DF (by Goodison) on GCSE results day (Thursday 20th August) **with your original GCSE results and your BTEC certificate**. These will be processed on the day to confirm your place at either our Jericho or Vauxhall sites.

GCSE results day is on Thursday 20th August. Our sites at Vauxhall (Ellesmere Port) and Everton Free School (Spellow Lane) will be open from 9.30-3pm. This is for all students who are receiving GCSE results and wish to progress to another course at college. Our Yr 12 Level 3 students **do not** have to attend this unless they are picking up additional GCSE results.

We are likely to be extremely busy on these days and to keep everybody safe and to enable us to observe social distancing, please bear in mind that it may take a while to process your application.

It is vitaly important that all new students wishing to study with us from September bring their GCSE and other results with them on this day to enable us to process your application. Without these you will not be able to enrol.

If you cannot make this date, and it is possible and safer to do this from home please can you confirm your results and your interest in a place with us at Everton via email.
